

(a) lie against any member of the Council or the Managing Director for any act done in pursuance or execution of this Act or any other law or enactment, or of any public duty or authority or in respect of any alleged neglect or default in execution or this Act or such law or enactment, duty or authority; and

(b) be instituted in any court unless-

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Act, among other things, expands the membership of representations of the communities affected by the activities of hydro-electric power producers and replaces the 30% revenue derived from the total revenue accruing to the companies or authorities operating in the host communities with 10% revenue derived from concessioning of the hydro plants and royalties paid to the Federal Government.

"Member Stales" means Kebbi, Kogi, Kwara, Niger, Plateau and any other State where hydroelectric power is generated; and

"President" means the President and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces or the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

SCHEDULE

Section 4

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISION RELATING TO THE COUNCIL, ETC.

Proceedings of the Council

1.--(1) Subject to this Act and section 27 of the Interpretation Act, the Council may make standing orders regulating its proceedings or those of any of its committees.

(2) The quorum of the Council shall be the Chairman or the person presiding at the meeting and four other members of the Council, and the quorum of any committee or the Commissions shall he as determined by the Council.

(3) The Council shall meet whenever it is summoned by the Chairman and if the Chairman is required to do so by notice given to him by less than four other members, he shall summon a meeting of the Council to be held within 14 days from the date on which the notice is given.

(4) At any meeting of the Council, the Chairman shall preside but if he is absent, the members present at the meeting shall appoint one of them to preside at the meeting.

(5) Where the Council desires to obtain the advice of any person on a particular matter, the Council may co-opt him or such period as it deems fit but a person who is in attendance by virtue of this sub-paragraph shall not be entitled to vote at the meeting or the Council and shall not count towards a quorum .

(6) The validity or any proceeding of the Council or of a committee shall not be adversely affected by-

(a) a vacancy in the membership of the Council or committee;

(b) a defect in the appointment of a member of the Council or committee; or

(c) reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the proceedings of the Council or committee.

Committees

(7) The Council may appoint one or more committees to carry out, on behalf of the Council, such functions as the Council may determine.

(8) A committee appointed under this paragraph shall consist of the number of persons as may he determined by the Council and a person shall hold office on the committee in accordance with terms of his appointment.

(9) A decision of a committee of the Council shall be of no effect until it is confirmed by the Council.
